

THE 2022 CALIFORNIA MISSION OFFERING STORY

At the close of 2021, the Executive Board of the California Southern Baptist Convention planned and budgeted for \$400,000.00 to be spent furthering kingdom work in California for the 2022 ministry year. In faith, they planned that the Lord would provide those funds through the generosity of our supportive, partnering churches. All told, churches contributed \$406,945.00 and we praise the Lord for your faithful giving!

In addition, California was blessed in 2022 with an unanticipated one-time gift of \$216,414.00, bringing the total income dollars to \$623,359! This significantly impacted what could be achieved in our state. Being certain to exercise trustworthy stewardship, those additional funds will resource gospel initiatives for well into 2023 and beyond.

The ministry breakdown of funds available per ministry was designated to:

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As you can see from the breakout above, California Mission Offering supports the California Southern Baptist Convention of churches to accomplish ministry within our state. Alternatively, Cooperative Program funds are utilized to pay the convention bills, staff salaries, fund our annual meeting, as well as support our two entities (California Baptist University and The Baptist Foundation of California). Our portion of funds given to the national agencies also comes from CP monies.

CMO allows us to fund ministry opportunities such as:

Retreats for pastors and wives (Missions)

Associational trainings for Vacation Bible School (Evangelism)

Training consultants to come alongside churches (Church Matters)

Trainings for new Disaster Relief volunteers (DR)

Purchasing food, clothing, tracts and Bibles for Migrant workers (Migrant Ministry)

And a large portion of our CMO funds go directly to support Church Planters with the CSBC compliance suite, to help new churches pay their pastor's salary, and with one-time startup grants. (Church Planting) and much more

Additionally, we are in year two (of a 5-year endeavor) of an exciting partnership with Gateway Seminary and the International Mission Board where \$10,000 are given annually toward the mobilization of California churches for missions through IMB's Asian Pacific Rim Peoples Affinity Group.
