

CSBDRM – CHAPLAIN REQUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS



DR Chaplains needing Requalification are in one of the following 6 categories. All California SBC DR Chaplains must complete the Basic Requirements in addition to those in their category:

Basic Requirements for all CSBCDR Chaplains Requalification:

- Complete a new background check, **and** complete all the following Reading Requirements:

- 1. Volunteer CSBCDR Chaplain who has deployed as a chaplain during the past three years**
 - Basic Requirements for all Disaster Relief Chaplains Requalification, **and**:
 - OSFA – 6-hour course (only option that meets NAMB endorsement requirements), **or one** of the following
 - NCTSN (National Child Traumatic Stress Network) Learning Center [Psychological First Aid course online](#) (free, 6-hour class) if you have not completed this course in the last 3 years. Register with this organization to get credit and provide completion certificate to Regional Lead Chaplain.
 - Repeat 2-day CSBCDR Chaplaincy Manual course
 - CISM: Spiritual & Psychological First Aid if you have not completed this course in the last 3 years
 - CISM: Emotional & Spiritual Care in Disasters if you have not completed this course in the last 3 years

- 2. Volunteer CSBCDR Chaplain who has not deployed as a chaplain in the past three years**
 - Basic Requirements for all Disaster Relief Chaplains Requalification
 - OSFA – 6-hour course if you have not completed this course in the last 3 years
 - Repeat 2-day CSBCDR Chaplaincy Manual course

Chaplains in one of the following 4 special categories – requirements are listed below:

- 3. Professional chaplain, working 20+ hours per week or full-time in a chaplain position**
- 4. Active-duty military chaplain**
- 5. Voluntary chaplain who provides 20+ hours per week of chaplain ministry for a specific organization**
- 6. Chaplain supervisor/instructor/educator who provides 20+ hours per week of such ministry**
 - Name of institution/agency/organization/company/branch of service:

 - Basic Requirements for all Disaster Relief Chaplains Requalification
 - Provide to Regional Lead Chaplain the completed requalification form with signature of direct supervisor verifying status and hours
