The summer before Leslie Montgomery started 8th grade, her church hired a youth pastor whose parents served as missionaries in Tanzania. Hearing them share what they had experienced “literally changed my life,” she said.

She didn’t feel ready as a teenager or college student to go on a mission trip. Then, she got married and had a baby. Then, there was a global pandemic. Leslie had no idea when her young family would bring the Gospel to Africans who needed to hear it.

One spring afternoon, God opened her husband’s heart to this call, too. The family knew it was time. They were all in.

In March 2023, the Montgomerys and their two-year-old son, Brock, moved to South Africa to disciple university students.

“God has given us a heart for university students, and we know the incredible impact they can have on their friends, families, and communities,” Leslie said.
